Valentine's Day in History in the UK

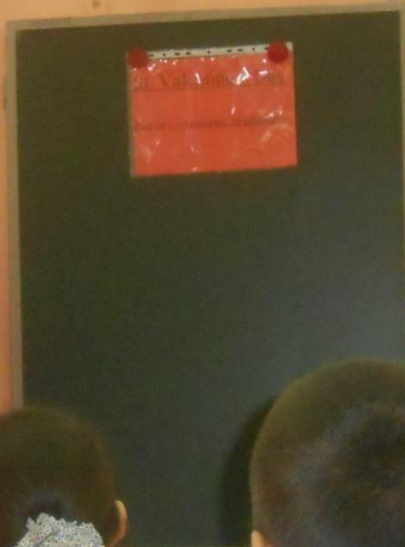
Valentine's Day had its origin in the popular belief held by people in Great Britain and France during 14th and 15th century that birds begin to mate on February 14.

Queen Elizabeth I is the Queen of England. She became Queen in February 1558, after her father died. She was crowned a year later in a special ceremony at Westminster Abbey in London.

Queen Elizabeth II is married to Prince Philip, the Duke of Edinburgh. They were married in 1947. They have three sons and one daughter. The Queen's official home is Buckingham Palace, London.

The year 2012 was an important year for the Queen. It marked her Diamond Jubilee. Queen Elizabeth II had been Queen for sixty years in 2012. Lots of special events took place in 2012 to mark the sixtieth anniversary of her reign.

The Queen and Prince Phillip visited many parts of the UK in 2012. They toured England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. Queen Elizabeth is also the Queen of Sixteen other nations around the world. Members of the royal family toured the world in 2012 to mark her Diamond Jubilee.

There was an extra bank holiday on Tuesday 5 June 2012, to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee. A bank holiday is a day when banks and many shops and businesses close. Most people in the UK had the day off work when the Queen's Diamond Jubilee was celebrated.

The Queen celebrates two birthdays a year. She was born in April 1926. She has an official birthday in the first week of June. In April 2012, she turned 86 years old.

AMERICAN PRESIDENTS



Washington assumed command of the Continental Army in the field at Cambridge, Massachusetts, in July 1775, during the ongoing siege of Boston. Realizing his army's desperate shortage of gunpowder, Washington asked for new sources. American troops raided British arsenals, including some in the Caribbean, and some manufacturing was attempted. They obtained a barely adequate supply (about 2.5 million pounds) by the end of 1776, mostly from France.

The Electoral College elected Washington unanimously as the first president in 1789, and again in the 1792 election; he remains the only president to have received 100 percent of the electoral votes. John Adams, who received the next highest vote total, was elected Vice President.

In February 1793 a major war broke out between conservative Great Britain and its allies and revolutionary France, launching an era of large-scale warfare that engulfed Europe until 1815. Washington, with cabinet approval, proclaimed American neutrality. The revolutionary government of France sent diplomat Edmond-Charles Genet, called "Citizen Genet," to America.

By 1798, relations with France had deteriorated to the point that war seemed imminent, and on July 4, 1798, President Adams offered Washington a commission as lieutenant general and commander-in-chief of the armies raised or to be raised for service in a prospective war. He reluctantly accepted, and served as the senior officer of the United States Army between July 13, 1798, and December 14, 1799. He participated in the planning for a Provisional Army to meet any emergency that might arise, but avoided involvement in details as much as possible; he delegated most of the work, including leadership of the army, to Hamilton.

Washington died at home around 10 p.m. on Saturday, December 14, 1799, aged 67. The last words in his diary were "Tis well."

Along with Martha's biological family, George Washington had a close relationship with his nephew and heir, Bushrod Washington, son of George's younger brother, John Augustine Washington. After his uncle's death, Bushrod became an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States.

In 1991, Obama accepted a two-year position as Visiting Law and Government Fellow at the University of Chicago Law School to work on his first book.

From April to October 1991, Obama directed Illinois's Project Vote, a voter registration campaign with ten staffers and seven hundred volunteer registrars. It achieved its goal of registering 150,000 of 400,000 unregistered African-Americans in the state, leading Crain's Chicago Business to name Obama to its 1993 list of "40 under forty" powers to be.

Obama was elected to the Illinois Senate in 1996, succeeding State Senator Alice Palmer as Senator from Illinois's 13th District, which at that time spanned Chicago South Side neighborhoods from Hyde Park — Kenwood south to South Shore and west to Chicago Lawn.

In May 2002, Obama commissioned a poll to assess his prospects in a 2004 U.S. Senate race; he created a campaign committee, began raising funds, and lined up political media consultant David Axelrod by August 2002. Obama formally announced his candidacy in January 2003.

Obama held assignments on the Senate Committees for Foreign Relations, Environment and Public Works and Veterans' Affairs through December 2006.

On February 10, 2007, Obama announced his candidacy for President of the United States in front of the Old State Capitol building in Springfield, Illinois.

On April 4, 2011, Obama announced his re-election campaign for 2012 in a video titled "It Begins with Us" that he posted on his website and filed election papers with the Federal Election Commission.

In a 2006 interview, Obama highlighted the diversity of his extended family: "It's like a little mini-United Nations," he said. "I've got relatives who look like Bernie Mac, and I've got relatives who look like Margaret Thatcher."

Obama tried to quit smoking several times, sometimes using nicotine replacement therapy, and, in early 2010, Michelle Obama said that he had successfully quit smoking.

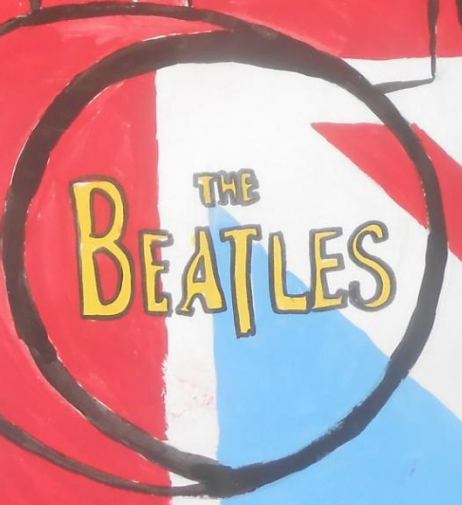

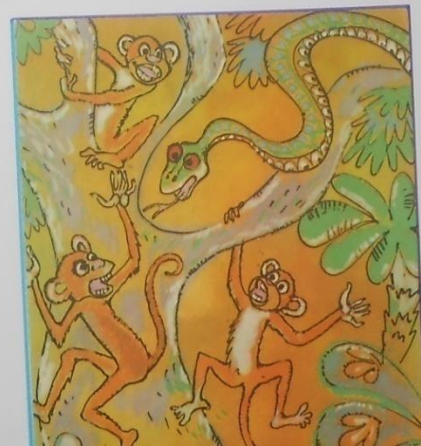
Kipling (Kipling) Joseph Rudyard (30.12.1865, Bombay, -18.1.1936, London), English writer. The son of colonial administrator-intellectual.

In 1882-89 lived in India, worked in the newspaper, published a collection of poems "Departmental song" (1886), and a collection of short stories "Simple stories from the mountains" (1888). Hero of the first novel To. "the Light went out" (1890, Russian lane. 1903)... and etc., in which depicts the daily life of soldiers, petty officials, their devotion to duty to the Empire. Criticizing the British colonial administration ("Паджет, member of Parliament"), accusing the British government and the military command in the neglect of the lower ranks ("Tommy"), K. creates the impression of an impartial objectivity of their views. However, his work is extremely biased in the approval of the "civilization" the mission of the Anglo-Saxon race among the "backward" the peoples of the East ("the Burden of the white man", 1899). Later works of K. in artistic terms insignificant.

The best poems To. close to the English folk songs and ballads, different dynamic rhythms, full of rough humor, shaped vernacular. 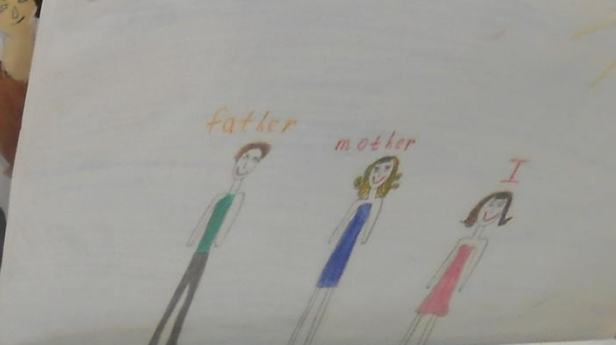
My family.

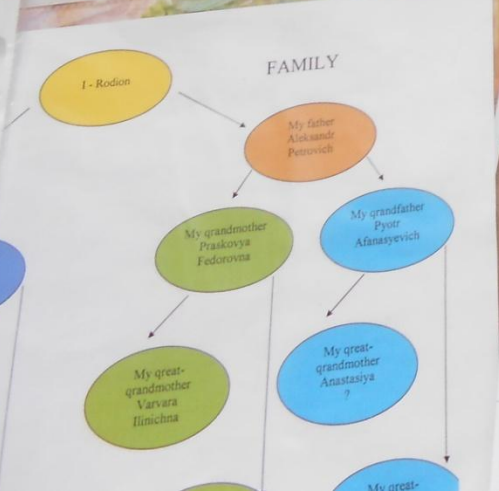

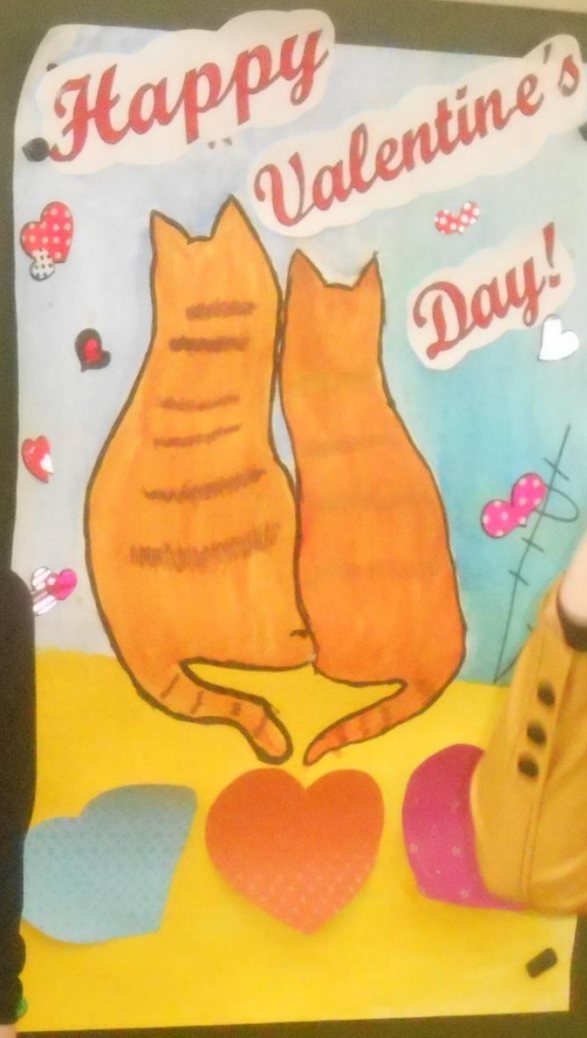
