We visited our school museum and learned some information about the history of our school. The first directors of the school were Vera Vasilievna Bobrova, Maria Andreevna Milnikova, Rufim Pavlovich Kostilev.



During the Great Patriotic War there was a hospital in the school. In 1942 the pupil of the 2d form Mara Koleva suggested to get money to buy a tank. 180 thousands roubles were got. On the 15th of April, 1943 the "Pupils' Tank" was sent to the front. It was called "Школьник Свердловска".



2. School in modern times.

In 1992 Galina Nikandrovna Arbuzova became a director of the school. She is a director of the school now. She is a real professional. She loves children and does her best for the school!



In 2002 the school was rebuilt. Now it is beautiful!

In front of the school there are a lot of trees, bushes and flowerbeds. Behind the school there is a playground and a football pitch.

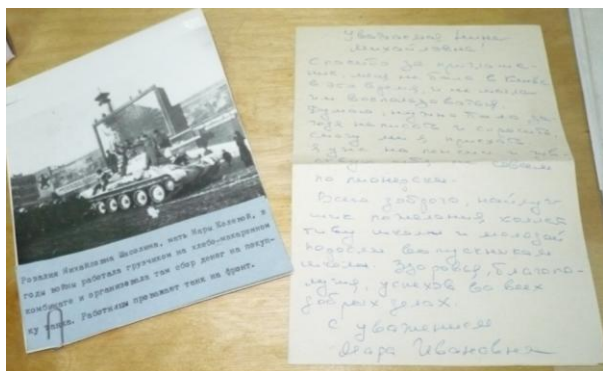

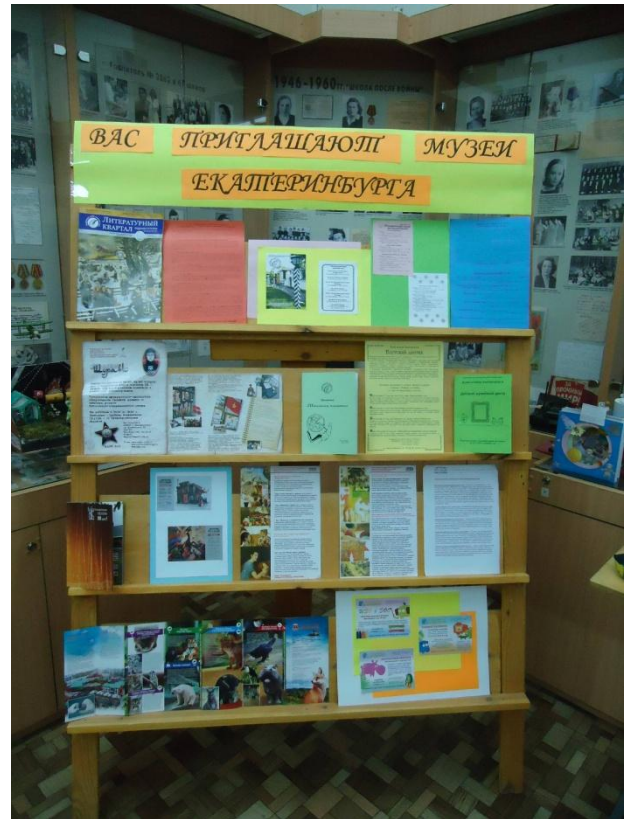
2.1. The museum of our school.

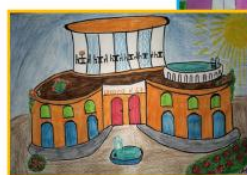
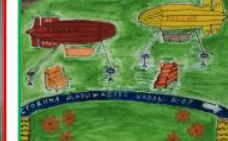
