# Flag



Stars and Stripes, is the official state symbol of the United States.

It is a rectangular panel with seven red and six white horizontal stripes of equal alternate. In Kryzhov dark blue - 50 five-pointed white stars. 13 stripes symbolize the 13 colonies, which formed an independent state.

Blue symbolizes Kryzhov Union. The number of stars in the blue Kryzhov corresponds to the number of states. The red colorsymbolizes the endurance and courage, dark blue - hard work, justice, vigilance, white - innocence and purity.

The country is 9519431 sq. km.




#### Location

### Rivers, lakes, mountains


