The ninth of May is the Day of the legendary victory over the Nazi invaders, as well as the Day of Remembrance of the soldiers who fell in the Great Patriotic War.

The Soviet Banner of Victory was the banner raised by the Red Army soldiers on the Reichstag building in Berlin on 30 April 1945, the day after Adolf Hitler committed suicide. It was raised by three Soviet soldiers: Ukrainian Alexei Berest, Russian Mikhail Yegorov, and Georgian Meliton Kantaria.

According to the Law of the Russian Federation, the Banner of Victory is to be stored forever in a place which provides its safety and public availability. The original Victory Banner is saved in the Central Museum of the Armed Forces, Moscow.

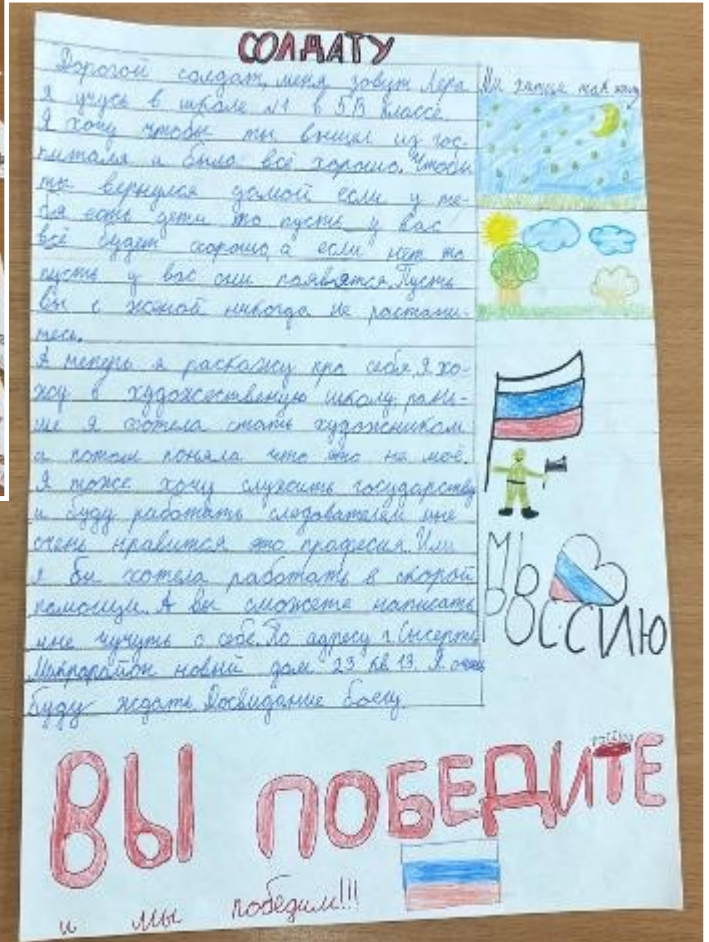

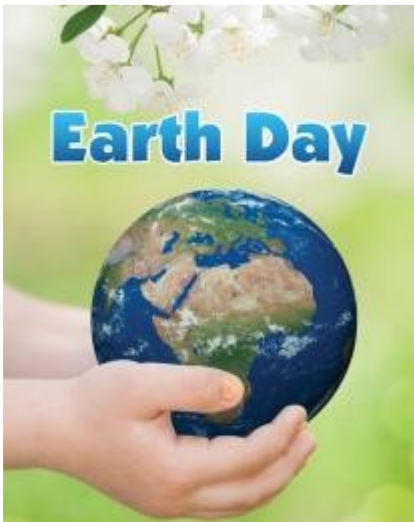

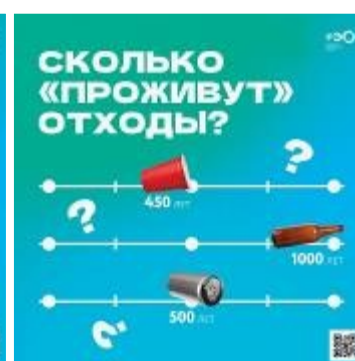
The official theme for 2024 is «Planet vs. Plastics».

Varwin Хакатон 2024



Varwin Hackathon 2024 is an All-the-Russia's competition for schoolchildren and students in 3D/VR development on the Varwin platform. As part of the hackathon, teams need to develop a prototype of a digital product in a certain amount of time to solve the tasks of business customers.

1,374 people (547 teams) from 64 regions of Russia registered for the hackathon. 177 teams qualified for the qualifying stage. 25 teams reached the final: 65 schoolchildren and students competed for the title of the best 3D/VR developers and prizes!

On April 24-27, the final of the competition took place in St. Petersburg.

It was an exciting day at the Varwin Hackathon! Our guys Artem Solomein (10th grade) and Maxim Sokolov (the Center for Children's Technical Creativity of Sysert) were able to go through a real test, presenting their projects to 3D technology specialists. They had to master two new programs in just two days. They coped with this challenge with a bang!

We are proud of the guys and their leader Anton Sergeevich Sharapov for their diligence, talent and dedication to their projects. Their work looked amazing and got the high praise from the jury. They took the 2nd place in two nominations.

St. Petersburg, the northern capital of Russia



Saint Petersburg is the second largest and important city in Russia. It is often called the northern capital, which means it has nearly equal status with Moscow.

Another amazing place I visited was the Grand Maket Russia - the national



show museum. This huge model, the second largest in the world, is an amazing combination of collective images of Russian regions on a scale of 1:87.

The Artmuz Museum of Contemporary Art also left an unforgettable impression. This is a place where you can plunge into the world of contemporary art and see the works of talented artists.

And, of course, a walk through Peterhof - a palace and park ensemble on the shores of the Gulf of Finland - was simply magical. These beautiful palaces and parks left me with an unforgettable impression.
