
The aim of the project is to develop students' cognitive interest in studying history of their native land, forming their tolerance and patriotism.

The house holds many unique objects of the Russian peoples' daily life in the 19th and early 20th centuries.

The exhibits include works made by gifted local artists and also kitchen utensils, spinning wheels, a weaving loom, Russian sledges and other objects created by anonymous folk craftsmen.

Local History Museum



Today's exposition of the museum occupies five exhibition halls, that describe the history of Sysert from the past to the present day. In the museum you can see a unique collection of antique furniture, musical instruments of the late XIX century. Among the interesting exhibits visitors can see some products of the company «Uralhydromash», which include both modern production (hydraulic turbines) and products produced during the war of 1941-1945 (bombs, shells, grenades).



Sysert Plant-museum



Sysert plant-museum is being created on the initiative of our local historian Alexander Savichev.

An architect by education and a fanatical popularizer of his hometown, for several years Alexander has gathered like-minded people from among government officials, entrepreneurs and volunteers who consider Sysert the best place to live and are ready to make efforts to bring reality in line with their dreams.

Alexander Savichev: «I have the most important dream since my childhood. I want to open a museum about the plant at the plant. I want to show everyone the luggage of local lore that I have been collecting for 15 years.»



Sysert Plant-museum



Together with like-minded people, residents of the city, volunteers, businessmen, his friends and family, Alexander Savichev transformed the plant into a museum, held subbotniks, organized collections of exhibits for the museum.

Most of the requested materials were donated to the museum by companies and people who believed in the idea.

The premises of the museum are being renovated. The necessary furniture and equipment were purchased. All the information stands were made.

The exposition of the museum is about 110 sq. meters.




Sysert Plant-museum



The museum is dedicated to the history of the Sysert plant from the 18th century to the present day.



The development of the culture of everyday life, the development of education, transport and even art is associated with factories and plants here.

- creating a storage area for museum exhibits





And in a green lake with beautiful fish banks, and the second quarry was also - white-green lake, greenish blue shade with darker delicate crystals, green oblique walls, grey crystals. It is believed that the famous collection of granites by the last owner of the Sysert factory, Sidorovskiy, may be hidden in the bottom of the lake.

Lake Anshin Stone is located in the Malaya Sysert. The lake is used to be very deep. It is surrounded by the forest and mountains. The water in the lake is very clean. On hot summer days we often swim in the lake. In winter we gather mushrooms far from the lake. There are many berries and mushrooms in the nearby forest. In winter we drive a snowmobile and go skating. Lake Stone is always beautiful - in all the seasons and in any weather.




Conclusions
